## **009. Tramore Star Flyer incident**

NAFLIC has been alerted to an incident which occurred at a fair in Tramore, Co. Waterford, Ireland, when a Star Flyer ride malfunctioned, reportedly resulting in six riders requiring evacuation from a considerable height.

IBs and operators are reminded that the device should be recoverable in all credible failure scenarios, regularly tested by the operator and all staff trained to deal with such circumstances. It must always be assumed that under certain circumstances this could happen so there must be a means of rescuing from height.
