037. Barriers on Juvenile Rides

In Technical Bulletin number 023 we drew attention to the Health and Safety Executive's proposed guidance on barriers for juvenile Chair-o-Planes, Paratrooper and similar rides.

We have been asked by the Showmen's Guild of Great Britain to report their disquiet over the text of the HSE's proposed guidance. They intend to put forward alternative recommendations for consideration at the next meeting of the JAC (Joint Advisory Committee for Health & Safety in the Fairground Industry) on Tuesday 16 February 1993.
