### TECHNICAL BULLETIN - FEBRUARY 1993

#### 048. Agreed Codes of Practice (Corrected May 1993)

Applicants for NAFLIC membership undertake to "... support the objectives of the Association, abide by the Constitution and observe the provision of any Code of Professional Practice adopted by the Association." (NAFLIC Constitution, III, 4(b)).

Sub-committees are currently preparing schemes for

- a) the certification of competence of member companies
  - b) guidance regarding design review, testing, thorough examination procedures etc.
- and parts of these are likely to be released for consultation shortly.

In the present situation the Management Council have decided that the Association should adopt, as minimum requirements appropriate to equipment for use in the UK, the following Codes etc :-

1. Fairgrounds and Amusement Parks - A Code of Safe Practice;

2. A Code of Safe Practice at Fairs - Technical Annex;  
Health & Safety Executive, ISBN 0 7176 0301 6; first published 1988.
3. All Documents, Standards and Codes referred to in either of the above publications.
4. All Guidance Notes from the Health & Safety Executive relating to amusement devices.
