TECHNICAL BULLETIN - FEBRUARY 1993

055. Code of Safe Practice Paragraph 215

At the meeting of the Joint Advisory Committee - Health and Safety in the Fairground Industry, on 16 February 1993, NAFLIC requested clarification on the new wording introduced into this paragraph (i.e. the last sentence) in the 1992 edition of the Code. It was considered that many rides (e.g. Ghost Trains) would not be able to comply with this part of the Code for the start of the 1993 season.

After some deliberation it was decided that, until further notice, the words "should be in full view of the person in control of the device and access to those conductors" may be deleted from the sentence.

The wording or application of the paragraph is likely to be considered by a JAC Working Party in due course.
