068. Information Required

The publication of NAFLIC Technical Bulletins relies upon there being a flow of information about incidents, accidents, and all other safety and certification matters.

Sources of intelligence include the Health & Safety Executive, BALPPA, Showmen's Guild of Great Britain, manufacturers and, primarily, NAFLIC member companies. The latter, who are generally employed in one or other function of bringing to light actual and potential safety problems, should be a particularly good source of news of the sort which appears in Technical Bulletins. However, a check through the files reveals that only about 10 (out of 36) NAFLIC member companies have ever submitted any information to the Sub-Committee. (Come on, you other 26, you must have some interesting stories to tell).

The nature of NAFLIC members' work means that they are regularly coming across problems which could be of interest to others in the field and to those in (or interested in) the broader leisure industry in general. We therefore repeat our plea for members and, indeed, others to provide the necessary facts. We would normally give credit to the information source and publish the details in a purely factual style.
