TECHNICAL BULLETIN - DECEMBER 1993

070. Reference to NAFLIC on Reports, Certificates etc.

The NAFLIC Management Council have asked us to prepare a Technical Bulletin covering the way in which they are happy for mention of NAFLIC to be made by members on reports, certificates, letterheads etc.

We have become aware of at least one instance of use of the phrase "NAFLIC Approved" on company paperwork. The Association does not at the moment "approve" its members although they have to agree to abide by certain rules and conditions. (In the not too distant future NAFLIC will be launching a scheme for member company accreditation which will be rather more rigorous).

We are also aware of instances of the use of "N.A.F.L.I.C." written in the style of a qualification after the name of the Appointed Person.

The Management Council are not happy with either of the above ways of referring to membership of NAFLIC. We believe that membership of the Association does, in general, indicate higher standards than those of non-members. Furthermore we wish members to gain the benefits of being able to declare their NAFLIC membership. In doing so we ask members to use suitable wording, such as "Member of NAFLIC", rather than implying approval or qualification.

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
