087. Concorde / Human Cannonball

NAFLIC member Leisure Technical Consultants Ltd have informed us of a matter relating to the Concorde and Human Cannonball amusement devices manufactured by Modern Products Limited of Scunthorpe.

It came to light that the damper units fitted to one of these devices, which are meant to provide a secondary system embracing the pneumatic lift bellows in the event of failure, are inoperable. The damper unit (1 per arm) is intended to control the descent of the car arm should the air bellow, which lifts the arm, fail during service.

It is possible that incorrect replacement damper units have been fitted since Modern Products point out that special units are one way dampers of a particular specification. We believe that the manufacturer will be issuing a Technical Data Sheet confirming the Part No. of the damper units and the method of periodic testing.
