123. IEC Standard - Electrical Installations in Travelling Funfairs and Circuses

A little time back we became aware of work being undertaken by an IEC (International Electro-technical Commission) working group, WG28, which includes advice on this subject. This has now proceeded to the point that there is a working draft dated October 1995. Its full title is

- *Publication 364: Electrical Installations of Buildings*
Part 7: Particular requirements for special installations or locations
Section 711A: Electrical installations in travelling funfairs and circuses.

At this stage the draft refers to both external supply arrangements and to internal elements of the ride such as emergency stops, motor contactors etc. As an international Standard it would have implications for designers, manufacturers and operators worldwide. It would also involve the need for changes to future versions of the IEE Regulations (BS 7671). NAFLIC are providing input to the preparation of this Standard. Anybody particularly interested in the draft may obtain a copy, via the NAFLIC office, at a members' price of £5.
