166. Agreed Codes of Practice

Applicants for NAFLIC membership undertake to "... support the objectives of the Association, abide by the Constitution and observe the provisions of any Code of Professional Practice adopted by the Association." (NAFLIC Constitution, III, 2).

In the present situation the Management Council have decided that the Association should adopt, as minimum requirements appropriate to equipment for use in the UK, the following Codes etc :-

1. Fairgrounds and Amusement Parks - Guidance on Safe Practice; HSG175, HSE Books, ISBN 0 7176 1174 4; first published 1997.
2. A Code of Safe Practice at Fairs: Technical Annex; Health & Safety Executive, ISBN 07176 0301 6; first published 1988.
3. All Documents, Standards and Guides referred to in either of the above publications.
4. All Guidance Notes from the Health & Safety Executive relating to amusement devices.

Members should note that failure to comply with these Codes may be taken as grounds for termination of membership under the NAFLIC Constitution, III, 4(b).

Bearing in mind the changes in the first item in the list compared with the previous edition of the Code of Safe Practice, and also other changes in circumstances, some NAFLIC Technical Bulletins have now been withdrawn and others have been overprinted. The latter are being re-issued, while the withdrawn Technical Bulletins are shown on the Index pages.
