268. Air Games Maxi Fun - Salto Trampoline Defect

Our Technical Bulletin number 263 discussed several issues that have arisen in connection with bungee / trampoline devices, of which there is a growing number of types in use.

During the winter 2003 / 2004, one supplier (Air Games Maxi Fun s.à.r.l. - Swiss company) circulated notice of a manufacturing defect on some Salto 4 Ways trampolines produced between November 2002 and March 2003. They say that there is a doubt over the aluminium alloy used in a batch of these machines - serial numbers 02120 - 02140 and 03160 - 03170.

The notification asks controllers of these rides to cease operation immediately until the problem is resolved.

If you need to make further checks, you are requested to note the serial number located on the central mast and, if relevant, to contact Air Games Maxi Fun directly. Their contact details are as follows :-
