039. Ferris Wheel incident, Australia

Three teenage girls were injured after falling 4m from a Ferris Wheel at an event in Liverpool, near Sydney, Australia. Unconfirmed reports say that the girls were moving around in the carriage and standing up, possibly causing it to become unstable and tipping them out. One witness is reported to have seen the passengers open the gate of the carriage. They received multiple fracture injuries.
