054. Boomerang coaster stop mid-ride

Four people are reported to have suffered minor injuries after the Boomerang roller coaster at Six Flags St. Louis in the US stopped mid-ride. In a statement the park is reported to have commented that the ride did not complete its normal ride cycle causing it to stop at a mid-point location where all guests safely exited the ride. First Aid staff responded immediately and four guests were taken to a local medical facility as a precaution.
