Log Flume ejection

NAFLIC has received reports of three people being thrown from a log flume ride at the Castle Park in Riverside, Southern California in May this year following a water pump malfunction.

According to fire department officials, all three were injured, one critically, as the log vehicle they were travelling hit the bottom of a water slide section, flipped over and ejected the riders. The incident highlights the requirement to ensure water ride levels are correct during operation and the need for management of this aspect.
