Waterslide injury

NAFLIC has received a report of a 23-year-old British man being involved in an accident at a Spanish waterpark, as a result of which he sustained serious injury.

The man was a visitor at the Aqualandia waterpark in Benidorm and went down the Splash waterslide on his stomach, as required, but suffered a broken neck seemingly at some point after entering the splash pool at the bottom. According to the report he could be left paralysed.

The report also states that the park believes the injured party did not follow guidelines for using the attraction but this is refuted by a member of the family.
