002. Reporting of Incidents to the Appointed Person (& NAFLIC)

Every now and again we hear of occasions where the Appointed Person has not been informed of an instance of minor or more severe injury. Likewise, replacement of components, repairs and modifications are sometimes carried out without being recorded or reported to the AP.

We would like to emphasise that all such information can be of assistance to persons responsible for ride examination in formulating their inspection schedules. Clearly, it is important that the Log Book and records of daily inspection should be perused before detailed examination begins.

We believe that it is in the interest of NAFLIC members to point out to clients the importance of recording ALL repairs, incidents etc.

Where there are implications for the safety of similar equipment we believe that NAFLIC can help in the process of spreading the word. Members should inform us as soon as they become aware of such a situation. Confidentiality can be preserved if appropriate!
