035. Code of Safe Practice, paragraph 90

We draw the attention of NAFLIC members to the changes to the requirements for Initial Test implied by paragraph 90 of "Fairgrounds and Amusement Parks - A Code of Safe Practice" published this year.

Prior to the new Code an Initial Test could be carried out by the manufacturer of a passenger carrying amusement device without reference to a third party. Note that paragraph 90 now includes the wording "... duly verified by a competent third party ...".

We hope to include further comment on this and some other changes introduced by the new Code in the next batch of Technical Bulletins (November 1992).
